## Water Play

Due to the hot weather we continued to engage in water play experience. We thank Chloe and Sienna who brought in their unicorn to help us cool down throughout the day. Educators discussed sun smart and water safety as children engaged in this sensory experience.



## Movie Day

To engage in the school holiday program children were provided with an opportunity to watch a movie during lunch and rest time. Children had a picnic lunch and popcorn while we watched Rio.



## Ice play

We extended water play this week by making ice. Children were encouraged to prepare this experience by placing various objects of their choosing in containers and filling with water. Children were then given the opportunity to work in groups to melt the ice and free the objects inside. Children developed turn taking skills, co-operation and problem solving as they try to find a solution to melt the ice.



## Slime

School aged children have been asking to make slime. To support this, educators provided them with the activator needed to make this. Jacinta, Chloe, Adrian and Lysandra, became educators as they led the session on how to make slime with the other children. They practice communication skills and built confidence as they demonstrated and supported others to participate in the experience.
